**SCHOOL NEWS**

It may be of interest to the Alumni members that the enrollment at Cedar Rapids High school has increased the past few years. Some of this is due to the closing of Primrose High school in 1966, and the closing of Belgrade High school in 1967. Cedar Rapids High school is fully accredited to the standards of the State Department of Education. St. Anthony's has also increased enrollment the past few years. Some of this is due to the closing of some of the outlying rural school districts and also due to the buses picking up children for both schools. This has been made possible due to the formation of a Bus Corporation a few years ago. This year St. Anthony's have the misfortune of losing one of their nuns, but plans are in the making to hire another lay teacher if possible. At the present time St. Anthony's have one lay teacher, Mrs. Robert Strickland and Sister Margaret Rita and Sister David Marie.

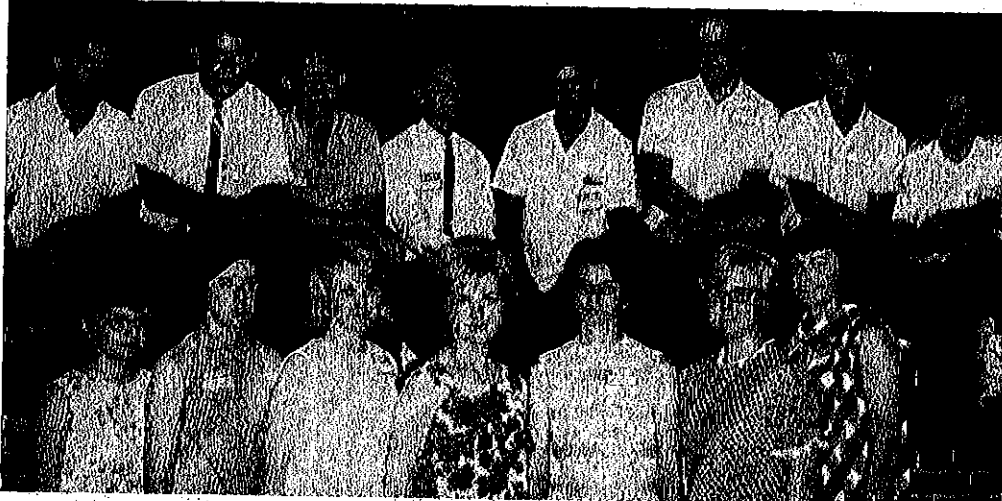

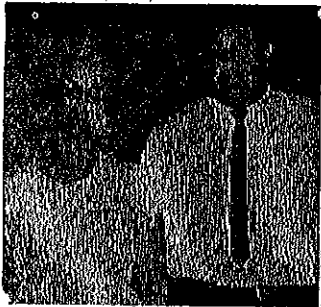

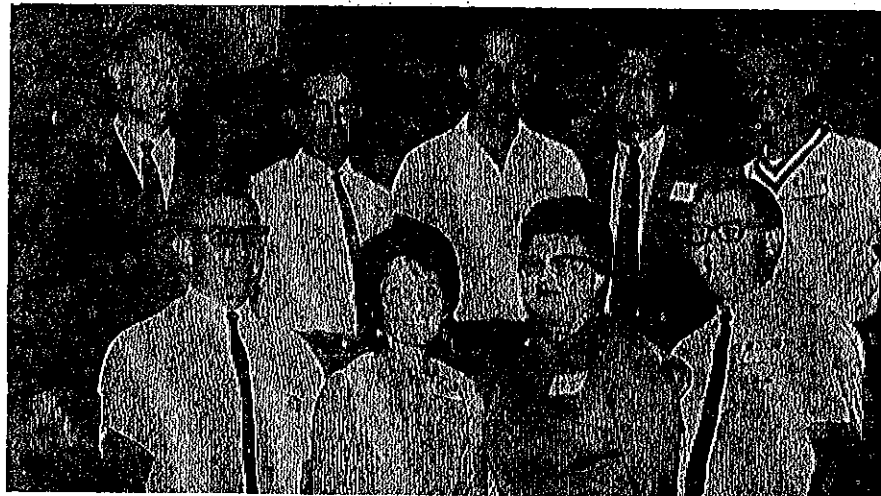

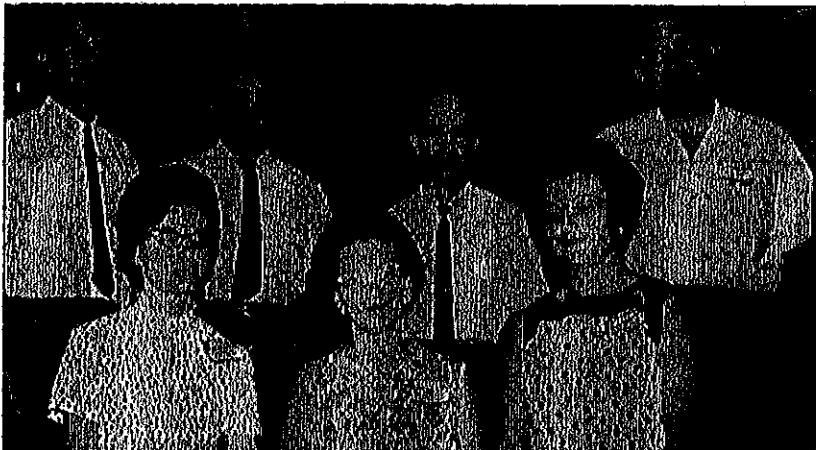

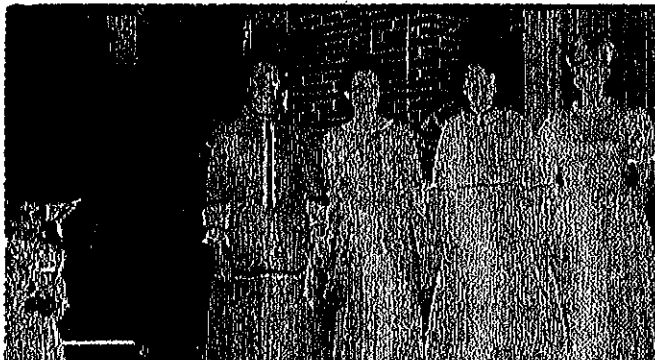

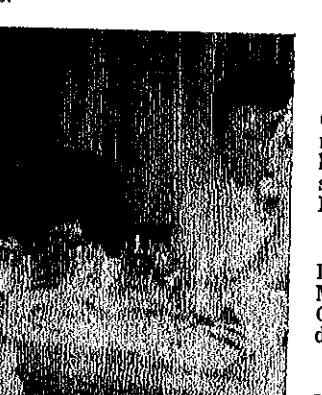
