## Explanation of dues

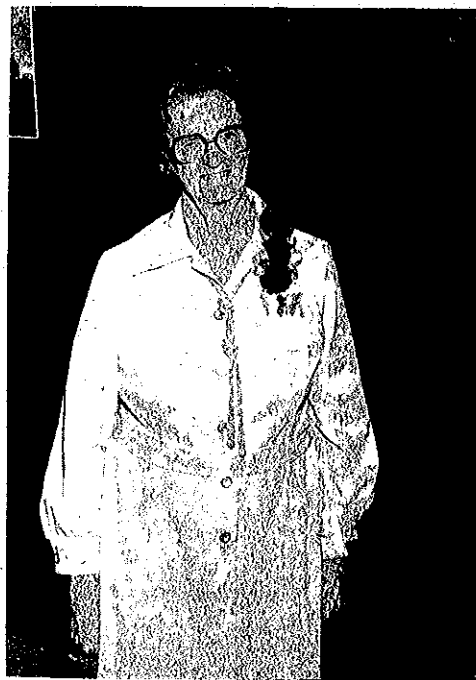

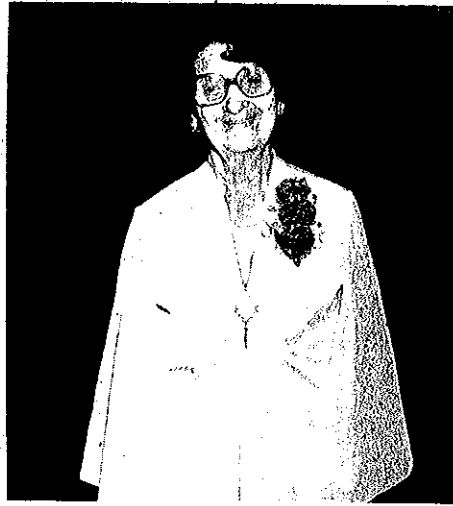
