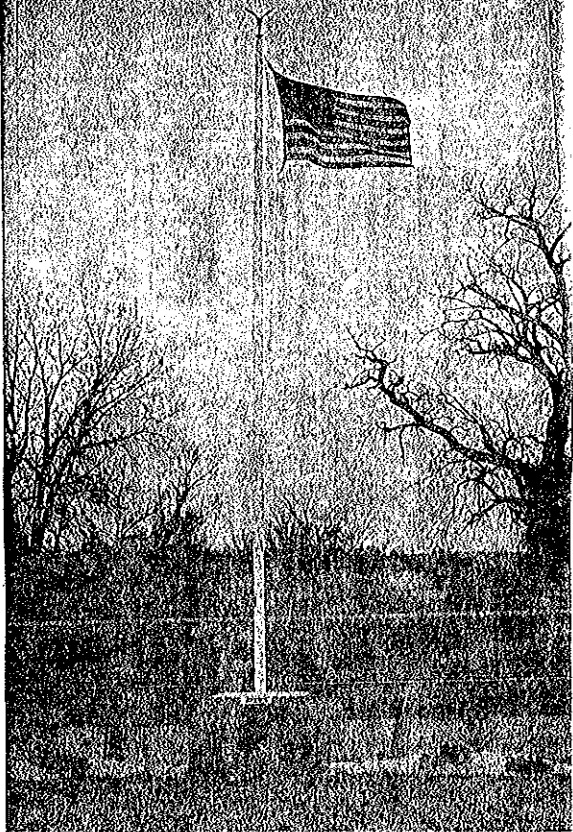

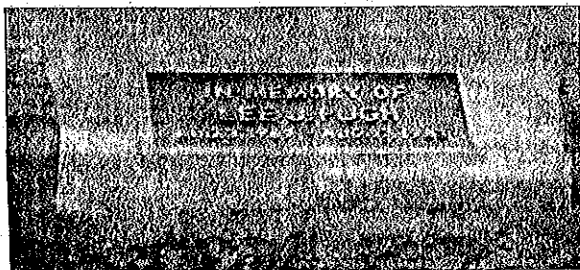


Memorial for Lee J. Pugh

A memorial for Lee J. Pugh has been erected on the east end of the football field in Cedar Rapids High School's new athletic complex. Lee J. was killed in an automobile accident on his way into football practice in August 1938. Lee J.'s love for sports prompted his family to erect a memorial on the athletic field. A brass plaque is embedded in a masonry base that holds a white fiberglass flagpole. A bordered rock garden completes the memorial area.

The memorial was dedicated before the first football game on the new field. Lee J.'s father, Virgil Pugh, raised the flag that will fly permanently over the site.

Regina (New) Wiese, Grand Island, Neb., wrote too, busy on the farm to attend.

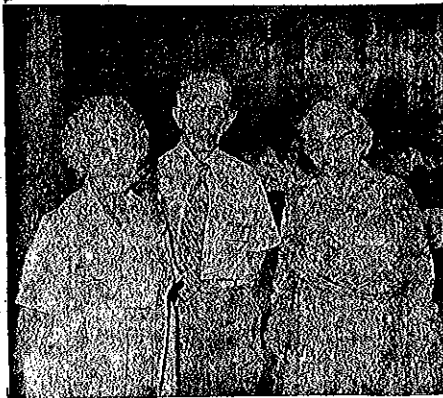
Betty (Rutten) Bradley, wrote going to be in Europe in July, so won't be able to attend.

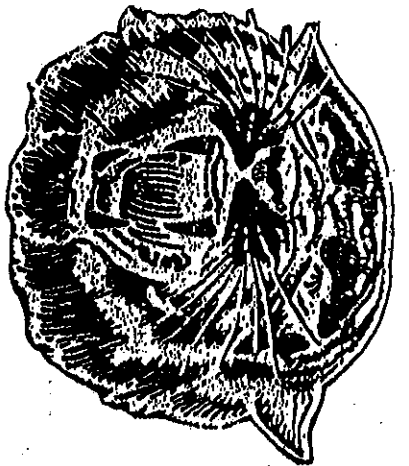
