Reunions reaffirm bonds that may have faded from sight- but not existence-over the years. There are chances to laugh at remembered pleasures, refresh old friendships and reevaluate the past with the wisdom of the present. They can also be just plain fun.

They're exhiturating! When people start describing their reunions, you can't stop them. "I have not yet been to a reunion or heard of one where people didn't say, 'Well, let's do this again."




