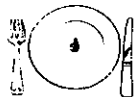

They're exhilarating! When people start describing their reunions, you can't stop them. "I have not yet been to a reunion or heard of one where people didn't say, 'Well, let's do this again.'"

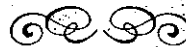

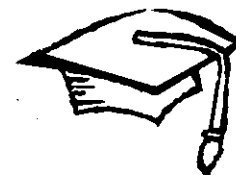
Cedar Valley Cooperative is co-sponsoring the project and Cenex Land-o-Lakes will provide matching funds up to \$1500.

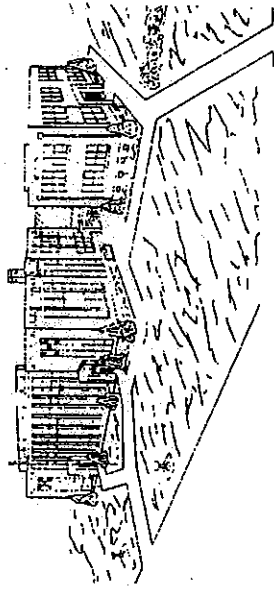
