NEW TO CEDAR RAPIDS

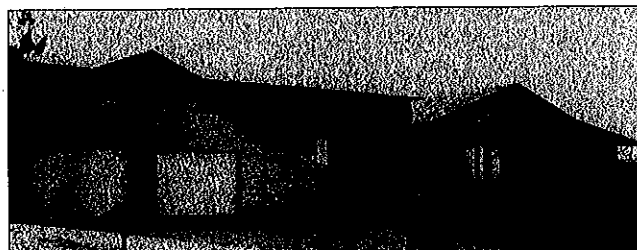
