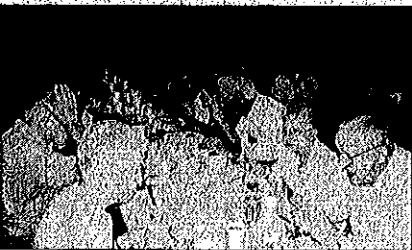

ALUMNI DUES ARE IMPORTANT

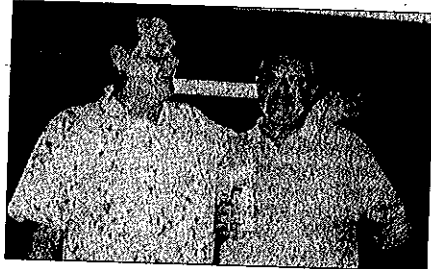

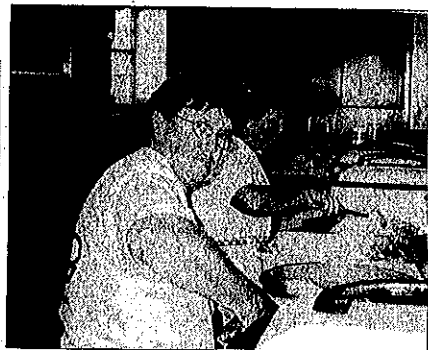

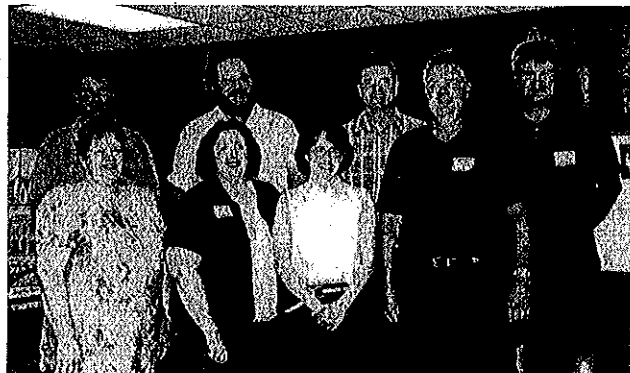

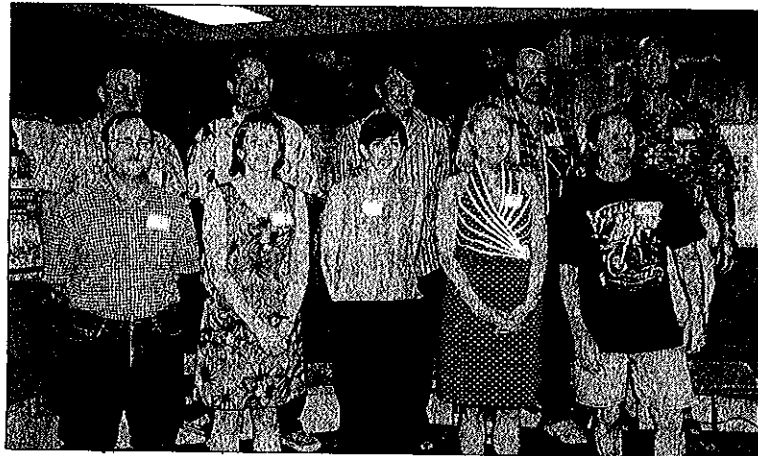

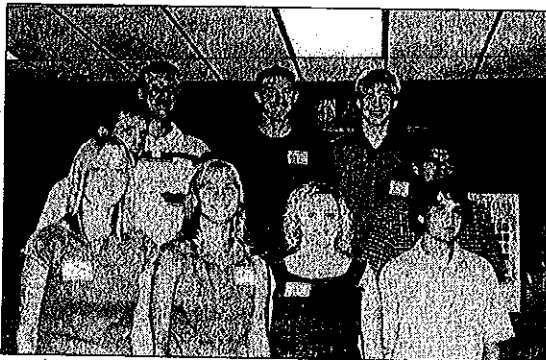

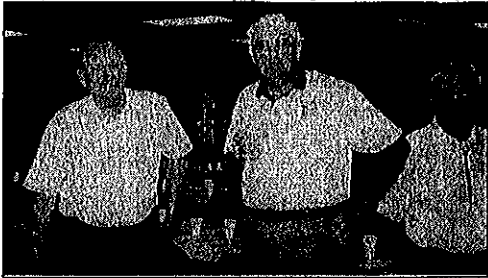
